Equipment: Each participating player should bring his/her own ball (size #3 for ages 4-7; size #4 for ages 8-9), shin guards, appropriate shoes (tennis shoes, soccer shoes) and clothing (Youth Academy jersey and shorts).

Instruction: Both practices and games will be supervised and instructed by a full rotation of qualified Longmont United clinicians and coaches.
